

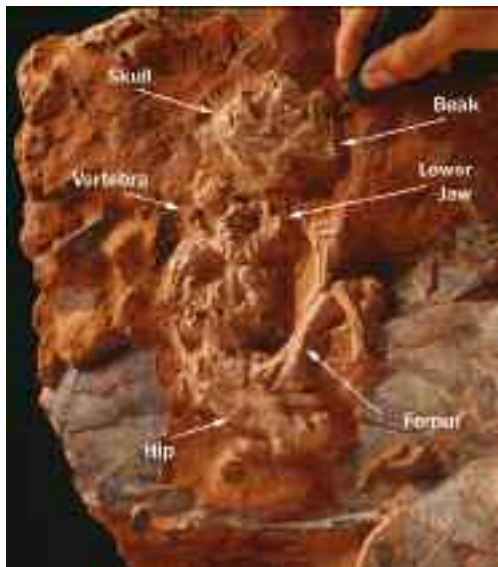
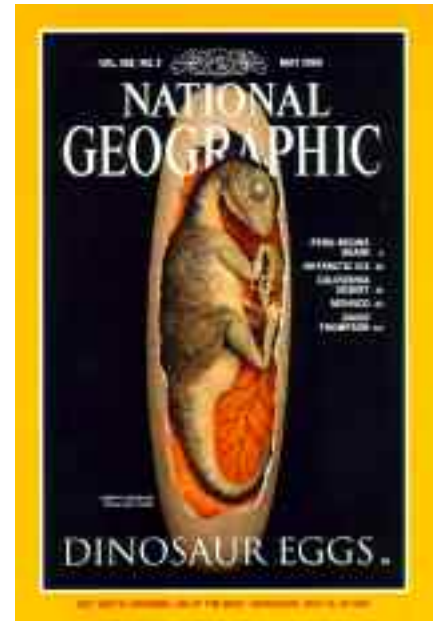


Section 6 - Oviraptor Hatchling

The only articulated dinosaur hatchling ever discovered was so rare and unusual that it was featured in the May 1996 issue of National Geographic Magazine. It was dubbed Baby Louie but was not officially named until 2005 when the first adult was discovered in China and named *Gigantoraptor*.
